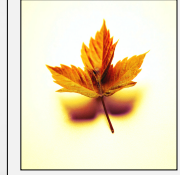
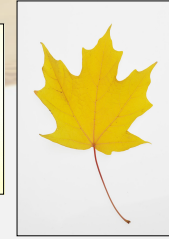

## Pastor's Corner



I've been reading a lot in the newspapers lately about "change". The president won the election with his proclamations that America needs "change". The car companies are talking about total changeovers in their organizations, designs, and manufacturing. Banks are getting caught up with having to "change" because of bad loans and bad management. The health care industry is also caught up in having to make changes due to new laws and consumer frustrations. The sad part of all this is that "change" is not what is really needed.

You can take a woman and paint her all up, give her a wig, put her in an expensive dress and shoes and she will look like a changed woman. The only problem is that she is still the same on the inside.

You can dress a man up, give him a good scrubbing, comb his hair (or polish his head), and spray on some good smelling stuff and you will be amazed how good he can clean up. But if you do not deal with what is on the inside, you have still got the same man!

Now, the truth is, America is facing a real crisis. We are facing a spiritual crisis. Many Christians have no power in their hearts and lives. They are not making a impact for the Lord in their lives and the power failure is becoming more and more evident. The "change" that America needs is not going to be found in the White House, nor in Lansing. The change that is needed is "Revival".

I know that "Revival" is a good, old-fashioned, Baptist word. But when most of us think of revival we think of a week of meetings with a guest speaker, special music, "pack-a-pew" nights, and pizza for the teens on Friday night. That, my friends, is not Revival. Those are "meetings", but not usually "Revival."

Revival is an awakening of the spirit. It brings a fresh enthusiasm for the Word of God and a heart-felt desire to please and honor the Lord. It produces a genuine conviction of sin and brings repentance. When real revival takes over time will not be a concern. Often, during the great revivals in the past, services would continue into the morning hours and the crowd not only did not disperse, but actually grew! The real Revivals in the past

were not produced by special speakers or special music and often did not begin in churches. They were the product of a few people gathering together to pray for revival. You see, revival cannot be planned and programmed, it must be prayed down!

I realize that most people will not immediately see how revival could possibly affect the economy or health care, but the truth is that revival can affect every facet of our lives. It can make businessmen honest, take away the greed that has caused the present turmoil, and produce a loving, caring spirit between people. It can turn us back to God and His Word and bring us back to His morals. It can cause rebellious teens and parents to love one another. It can make enemies into the dearest of friends. In other words, it can produce the "change" we need.

I would like to challenge you today to take up the responsibility of praying for a real, heaven-sent, old-fashioned, Holy Ghost moving Revival. Now, we do not have even a "meeting" scheduled in the near future. But "meetings" do not usually bring revival. Prayer does! Do we want it? Will we pay the price to experience it?
